Returning to School

A booklet for our children.

Arriving at School in the morning

- **One parent** can bring you to the back gate of the school every morning and one parent can pick you up. You will need to make your way to your classroom on your own. Look for the posters and arrows on the floor to help you or ask an adult downstairs
- Your parents cannot come into school at the moment but this does not mean that we will not stay in contact with them. If your parents need to let us know something about you, they can phone or email the school.
- You will remain in your class bubble throughout the day and will only join your year group bubble for playtime and lunchtime
- There will be a staggered start for different year groups so your friends may arrive at different times. You **MUST** keep to your



Other information

- School will be open **every day**. You are expected to attend every day unless you are unwell. You must be **on time** each morning!

Lunchtime

- If you normally bring a packed lunch to school then you will place your packed lunch box/bag underneath your table in your bubble.
- If you normally have school dinners, we will give you the menu the week before to make your choices. It is important that you stick to the choice you made.

School Uniform

- You will be expected to wear school uniform.
- You **must wear trainers** daily to take part in the Daily Mile and outside learning.
- On PE days, you must come to school in your PE kit. If it is cold, you may wear a tracksuit BUT no hoodies.
- No jewellery is allowed and long hair must be tied up

Daily Routines



At first school will feel very different but you will soon get used to new routines.

- You will sit at your table when you arrive in your room and put your coat and other belongings under the desk. You will then go and wash your hands .
- You will have opportunities to talk about how you feel every day to begin with to help you and your friends feel good. It's OK if you don't feel happy all the time. We will help each other.
- Once you are settled, you will continue to do lessons as per normal
- You will have hot dinners one week and a school packed lunch the next week. You will need to eat in your classroom during the packed lunch week
- You will have playtimes - these will be in your year group
- Learning in class will be different as we will all have to try stay apart more than usual. You will soon get used to it.
- Teachers will remind you of these routines—don't worry if you sometimes forget.

Keeping Safe

- You can wear a mask on your way to school but it must be removed at the school gate.
- You will only be able to bring your water bottle, reading book bag and packed lunch (if you have one) with you to school. You will not need any other equipment - don't worry. NO TOYS OR PHONES PLEASE
- We will be washing our hands **A LOT** for 20 seconds at a time with soap.
- You will need to use tissues to catch any coughs or sneezes and put these in the bin. Catch it, bin it, kill it.
- If you need first aid, an adult may need to wear a face mask and gloves when they help you.
- If you become poorly, your parent will collect you and take you home. You may have to stay there for a while and have a special test to check if you can come back to school.
- The staff will do their best to remind you how to stay safe and if we work together – we can do it!



Behaviour

We will still have the same high expectations of your behaviour.

We know that school is going to be different for all of us, but it is really important that we adapt our rules to make sure that we are looking after each other and staying safe. Our main behaviour rule is to keep yourself and others safe by:

Stay put



Stay clean



Stay apart



Make sure you continue to use your Oracy skills. Tell others when you are upset or worried!

Class Groups

- You will be in your class bubble throughout the day.
- You may work with a different teacher for science, PE and music—but these will all be safely organised
- You will have all the equipment you need at your own desk you don't need to bring things in
- We will do lots of exercise in the fresh air.
- We will do lots of learning outside.
- You will need to stay at your own desk when we are in classrooms. You will not be able to move around the room.
- You cannot share any equipment or food with anyone else.
- School will look and feel very different but we will look after you – don't worry.
