1. Where were you on the academic tables last year?
2. What is your school best known for: Academia ,sports, drama, SEN
3. How do you deal with incidents of bullying in the school?
4. Who would I talk to if my child was bullied?
5. What systems do you have in place to support my child's emotional wellbeing?
6. Do you have school counsellors on site?
7. What sort of communication should I be expecting from you.. how often?
8. In this current situation we know it is difficult to get into school to see someone, how will we be able to communicate any concerns we may have with you?
9. How often will I get an academic report on my child's progress?
10. If my child is falling behind, what systems will you have in place to support them
11. What happens if my child is excelling? How would you ensure they were supported?
12. How will I know who to speak to about different areas: eg lessons, bullying, behavior  
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13. What after school clubs/provision do you offer?
14. Lunchtime provision – do children go off site and if so how is this monitored?
15. what does my child need to bring with them daily?
16. What is your mobile phone policy?
17. What is your SEND provision like?
18. Can you talk me through your absence and lateness procedure?
19. What leadership opportunities are available for children
20. How do you support career opportunities and development in your school?
21. Can you talk me through your homework policy?
22. What remote learning opportunities are in place in case of further lockdowns or self-isolating incidents
23. How do I let you know about medical conditions ?
24. What before and after school provision is there
25. How do I pay for lunch?
26. Will I be contacted if my child has: behaviour issues, academic concerns, emotional concerns?
27. If my child shows talent in a certain subject – art, music, sport, science – how will I know what provision is available?
